

## WHAT IS BIOLOGICAL SEX?



- In biology, <u>male</u> and <u>female</u> are minor and often inconsequential categories.
  - The definition of a <u>male</u> is something that produces small gametes.
  - The definition of a <u>female</u> is something that produces large gametes.\*
- <u>That's it!</u> All other behavior and anatomy is not necessarily correlated to biological sex.

\*Gametes are reproductive cells that contain genetic material.




# CLOWNFISH



- Clownfish can <u>switch</u> between being male or female
- if a female clownfish is removed from a sea anemone, a male clownfish will turn into a female and <u>begin producing eggs</u>

### BLUEHEAD WRASSE



- Bluehead wrasse have <u>three</u> common sexes!
  - males, females, and female->
     male
- The female-> males are typically
   <u>larger</u>, <u>more territorial</u>, and have a
   <u>better chance at mating</u> with females
- The female -> male fish can begin producing sperm <u>after just 10 days</u>!

# MARINE MAMMALS



 Male dolphins and whales have internal genitalia

> internal testes, no scrotum, and an internal "genital slit."

- Gobies <u>switch back and forth</u> between sexes!
- <u>80% of juveniles mature into</u> <u>females</u>, then switch to male at some point in their life, and then switch back.

### BEARS

- IO-20% of the female population have <u>external genitalia</u> or a birth canal that runs through a penis
- This can be found in Grizzly bears, American black bears, and polar bears





 Many types of deer have <u>intersex</u> individuals

• "Velvet horn" males have small antlers, doe-like features, and small testes

• This can be found in white-tailed deer, black-tailed deer, elk, swamp deer, sika deer, roe deer, fallow deer, and moose

# KANGAROO RAT



- As many as 16% of kangaroo rats have <u>both sperm and egg-producing</u> <u>abilities</u>.
- Some individual kangaroo rats have a vagina, penis, testes, and uterus all in one!

- Both male and female hyenas have almost <u>identical penises</u>
- Female hyenas give birth through external genitalia





• Males and females both have <u>external genitalia</u> • i.e. a clitoris and penis that look almost indistinguishable

• This can be found in spider monkeys, bushbabies, woolly monkeys
